AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION HEARTSAVER FIRSTAID

This two and a half hour course will teach participants first aid. This class will cover the general principals of first aid in medical, injury, and environmental emergencies. This class is generally taken by teachers, lifeguards, day care workers, coaches and other members of the community who need a credentialed firstaid class, but do not work in the healthcare setting. All students will take a written and practical test at the end of class. For students who pass, they will receive an AHA Card, which is valid for two years.

AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION HEARTSAVER CPR/AED

This four hour course is an all-inclusive class that will teach participants adult, child and infant CPR, and AED use. This class is generally taken by teachers, lifeguards, day care workers, coaches and other members of the community who need a credentialed CPR class but do not work in the healthcare setting. All students will take a written and practical test at the end of class. For students who pass, they will receive an AHA Card, which is valid for two years.

AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION FAMILY & FRIENDS CPR

This two hour class teaches students how to perform CPR on adults, children and infants and how to help an adult, child or infant who is choking. It is designed primarily for those persons who want to learn CPR and do not need a certification for employment. This course is designed for parents, grandparents and members of the community who want to learn how to effectively help their friends and family in an emergency.

AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS (BLS)

This four hour course is designed specifically for medical and health professionals including nurses, nursing students, physicians, EMS personnel, dental and other healthcare professionals who need certification for a regulatory requirement. This program includes adult, child and infant CPR; one and two rescuer CPR; foreign body airway obstruction, mouth-to-mask, bag mask and use of an automatic external defibrillator. All students will take a written and practical test at the end of class. For students who pass, they will receive an AHA Card, which is valid for two years.

AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION SKILLS TESTING FOR BLS, ACLS or PALS

American Heart's Blended learning class is a great option for busy individuals who do not have time to take a traditional course or for individual in need of certification ASAP. Students complete an online course and then compete at practice and testing session with an instructor.

Skills testing sessions are designed to meet Part 2 (Practice) and Part 3 (Testing) of the HeartCode BLS, ACLS or PALS online programs and typically takes less than an hour. These skill sessions will cover the practical component required by the American Heart Association to receive the BLS, ACLS, or PALS Provider Card. Students will take an online class and will receive a course completion certificate. Students must bring this certificate from part one of the class and will then be tested following the required stations. **The online classes can be found at www.onlineaha.com and there is a cost for the online course which is paid to AHA.** Upon successful completion, students will receive an American Heart Association BLS, ACLS or PALS Provider cards which are valid for two years. Skills testing sessions are scheduled by request and can usually be scheduled to be complete within a few days of the request.
